RCBS seater dies have built-in taper or roll crimp ring appropriate for the cartridge. Seater dies are packed in an RCBS plastic die box and will fit any 7/8 to 14 reloading press.

# RCBS Bullet Seater Die Safety Instructions

## Introduction
