They cut the depth of primer pockets to the correct SAAMI specification and also clean the carbon out of the primer pocket after each firing. Available in 4 sizes: Large Rifle, Small Rifle/Pistol, Large Pistol, and a PPC/BR uniformer.

- Wipe the uniformers with a clean, dry cloth to remove any debris or residue.
- Store the uniformers in a protective case or designated storage area.
