Heat treated in atmospherically controlled furnaces and hand polished for smooth, flawless functioning, these dies will maintain tolerances and last a lifetime. Inspected and ultrasonically cleaned before packaging.

Safety Instruction Guide for Redding Neck Sizing Die 22250 Rem

Introduction
