Davidson Action Wrenches are designed for the switch barrel shooter with a custom built rifle. Manufactured from 7075-T6 aluminum, these tools are not designed to remove factory installed barrels. Action wrenches are used to break the action free from the barrel while the barrel is held in a barrel vise. This allows the shooter to change barrels in a matter of a few minutes. All rear action wrenches are inserted through the rear of the action and have a 3/4 inch hex end which requires a wrench for turning. Port wrenches are inserted through the action port and are turned by hand. Barrel Vise available separately.

Safety Instruction Guide for ACTION WRENCHES DAVIDSON PORT ACTION WRENCH STOLLE NESIKA BAY (RH)

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Davidson Action Wrenches. These tools are designed specifically for switch barrel shooters using custombuilt rifles. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe usage and compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

- Insert the rear action wrench through the rear of the action.
- Attach a compatible wrench to the 3/4 inch hex end.
- Gradually apply torque to break the action free from the barrel.
- Ensure that the barrel is securely held in the barrel vise during this process.

3. Using the Port Wrench:

- Insert the port wrench through the action port.
- Turn the wrench by hand to break the action free from the barrel.
- Avoid using excessive force; if resistance is met, reassess the setup.

4. Changing Barrels:

- Once the action is free, carefully remove the barrel from the vise.
- Follow the reverse process to install a new barrel, ensuring it is properly aligned and secured.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the action wrench responsibly at a designated recycling facility or according to local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the tool in general waste.
