The Wilson chamber type bullet seater is a favorite among benchrest shooters. A chamber type bullet seater positively controls both bullet and cartridge case alignment. The case and bullet are completely captured by the die prior to the bullet being pushed straight into the case by a close-fitting seating stem. This style of bullet seater works more accurately than a conventional 7/8 inch to 14 bullet seating die. This is one of the most accurate bullet seaters ever made!

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the CHAMBER TYPE BULLET SEATER DIES 7X57MM MAUSER BULLET SEATING DIE. This product is designed for precision bullet seating, particularly favored by benchrest shooters. Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation

- Ensure that your reloading press is compatible with the 7/8 inch x 14 thread size.
- Securely attach the bullet seating die to the reloading press, tightening it as required.
- Insert the closefitting seating stem into the die, ensuring it is properly aligned.

2. Usage

- Prepare your cartridge case and bullet according to standard reloading practices.
- Insert the cartridge case into the die, ensuring it is fully seated.
- Place the bullet on top of the cartridge case.
- Slowly and evenly operate the reloading press to push the bullet into the case.
- Monitor the seating depth to ensure it meets your specifications.
- Once completed, remove the seated cartridge from the die and inspect it for proper alignment and depth.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn components in accordance with local regulations.
- Recycle packaging materials where possible.
- Do not dispose of the die in regular household waste. Instead, consult local guidelines for proper disposal

of metal and reloading equipment.
