Pilots are used to support the case neck during case trimming. A collet and pilot are needed to operate this trimmer and are sold separately. Trimmer can be used for case length trimming, hollow pointing, neck turning, inside neck reaming, case mouth deburring, and primer pocket reaming (removes military crimps). The trimmer can be powered by a drill or power screwdriver by adding the Forster Power Adapter (#FPA1000). Requires Forster Trimmer Cutter w/Shaft 17 cal for use with .17 cal Pilot.
