Details like the 10-degree press tilt, the covered linkage, and the primer exit point make this press stand out from all others. Features:- Machined and contoured from a solid billet of aluminum.- A soft radius has been applied to all edges to eliminate sharp corners.- Primers exit through the bottom of the ram, keeping primer debris away from the linkages.- Throat opening of 2.5 inch will accept up to 308 case lengths for sizing (PPC's, BR's, 30x47, 308, etc.).- Heavy-duty linkage has no exposed clips, nuts, or bolts.- 10-degree press tilt for easy case insertion.- Optional mounting plate for quick takedown and compact storage.
