Forster's easy-to-use hand-held neck turning tool helps you take the next step toward cartridge-to-cartridge consistency. It features a carbide cutter with a micrometer- style adjustment knob for precise material removal to give cases consistent wall thickness that improves bullet-to-bore alignment. The aluminum holder retains the case firmly with a simple turn of the knob; holds up to .592" base diameter. Large case holder available for cases from .593" to .812" base diameter. Requires a pilot that's specific to the case mouth diameter; sold separately, see table below. Pilots are precision-ground .002" to .0025" smaller than the bullet diameter.

HAND HELD OUTSIDE NECK TURNER PILOT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the HAND HELD OUTSIDE NECK TURNER PILOT from Forster Products, Inc. This tool is designed to enhance your cartridge preparation process by ensuring consistent wall thickness and improving bullet bore alignment. To ensure safe and effective use, please read and follow the safety guidelines and instructions provided in this document.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the neck turner is used in a welllit, clean, and dry workspace.
- Keep the tool out of reach of children and individuals who may not understand its use.
- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as safety glasses, when using the neck turner.
- Inspect the tool before each use to ensure it is in good working condition.
- Do not use the neck turner for any purpose other than its intended use.
- Report any unsafe products or accidents to the relevant authorities.

- Always ensure the correct pilot is used for your specific case mouth diameter to avoid accidents.
- Do not exceed the specified base diameter limits when using the case holder.
- Avoid placing fingers or other body parts near the cutter while in operation.
- Use caution when adjusting the micrometerstyle adjustment knob to prevent injury from the cutter.
- If the tool becomes damaged or malfunctions, cease use immediately and contact customer support.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Selecting the Pilot:

- Choose a pilot that matches the case mouth diameter. Pilots are precisionground .002" to .0025" smaller than the bullet diameter.
- Pilots are sold separately; refer to the table provided by the manufacturer for options.

2. Preparing the Tool:

- Ensure the neck turner is clean and free of debris.
- Attach the selected pilot to the neck turner according to the manufacturer's instructions.

3. Loading the Case:

- Insert the case into the aluminum holder.
- Firmly secure the case by turning the knob until it is held in place.

4. Adjusting the Cutter:

- Use the micrometerstyle adjustment knob to set the desired material removal.
- Make small adjustments to ensure precision.

5. Turning the Neck:

- Hold the neck turner firmly and begin to turn the case.
- Maintain a steady pace to achieve consistent results.

6. Finishing Up:

- Once the desired thickness is achieved, carefully remove the case from the holder.
- Clean the tool after use to maintain its performance.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any waste material and used pilots in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the neck turner in regular household waste. Instead, follow local guidelines for electronic waste disposal.
