Also includes an enhanced ball handle for comfort, an extra-long ram bearing surface to eliminate wobble and ensure alignment of the case holder for dies, an on-press primer arm that lets you prime cases at the same time you resize them, and a removable bushing for using RCBS shotshell dies or the Piggyback Conversion Unit. The 7/8 x 14 thread accommodates most popular reloading accessories.
