Forster's easy-to-use hand-held neck turning tool helps you take the next step toward cartridge-to-cartridge consistency. It features a carbide cutter with a micrometer- style adjustment knob for precise material removal to give cases consistent wall thickness that improves bullet-to-bore alignment. The aluminum holder retains the case firmly with a simple turn of the knob; holds up to .592" base diameter. Large case holder available for cases from .593" to .812" base diameter. Requires a pilot that's specific to the case mouth diameter; sold separately, see table below. Pilots are precision-ground .002" to .0025" smaller than the bullet diameter.

Safety Instruction Guide for HAND HELD OUTSIDE NECK TURNER PILOTS

Introduction

- Turn the knob clockwise to secure the case firmly in place.
- Attach the selected pilot to the tool, ensuring it is properly aligned.

3. Usage:

- Adjust the micrometerstyle knob to set the desired material removal depth.
- Hold the tool with both hands for better stability and control.
- Begin the neck turning process by gently rotating the tool while applying consistent pressure.
- After completing the neck turning, release the knob to remove the case safely.

4. PostUsage:

- Clean the tool and store it in a dry, safe place away from children.
- Regularly inspect the carbide cutter for wear and replace it as necessary.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any worn or damaged parts in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the neck turner or its components in household waste.
- Consider recycling options for metal components where applicable.
