Forster's easy-to-use hand-held neck turning tool helps you take the next step toward cartridge-to-cartridge consistency. It features a carbide cutter with a micrometer-style adjustment knob for precise material removal to give cases consistent wall thickness that improves bullet-to-bore alignment. The aluminum holder retains the case firmly with a simple turn of the knob; holds up to .592" base diameter. Large case holder available for cases from .593" to .812" base diameter. Requires a pilot that's specific to the case mouth diameter; sold separately, see table below. Pilots are precision-ground .002" to .0025" smaller than the bullet diameter.

- Use the micrometerstyle adjustment knob to set the desired depth of material removal.
- Ensure the cutter is properly aligned with the case before beginning.

5. Operating the Tool

- Hold the tool securely and begin turning the cutter.
- Maintain a steady and controlled motion to achieve consistent wall thickness.
- Stop immediately if you notice any irregularities or if the tool feels unstable.

6. PostUse Care

- After use, clean the tool and remove any debris.
- Store the tool in its designated place to ensure it remains in good condition.
