Comes with two steel support rods to fit small and large primer pockets. Slide the case onto the steel rod, rotate the case down into position in the swager, and operate the handle to complete the job.

RCBS Primer Pocket Swager Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the RCBS Primer Pocket Swager Tool. This benchmounted tool is designed to safely and effectively remove militarystyle primer pocket crimps or staking from cartridge cases. To ensure safe and effective use, please read and follow these safety instructions carefully.
