The trimmer is designed for .001" accuracy. Course and fine trim length adjustments. Fine adjustment bushing features .001" micrometer markings. The spring-loaded shell holder will accommodate case head diameters from .250" to .625 rims. Case fit is from the 5.7x28mm to the long range .338 Lapua Magnum. Kit includes Pilots: .22, .24, .25, .27, .28, .30, .35, .44, .45 Individual trimmer pilots available separately.
