Safety Instruction Guide for Redding Premium Deluxe Die Sets 6.5X55mm Swedish

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Redding Premium Deluxe Die Set for your reloading needs. 4. Using the Bullet Micrometer Seating Die

- Adjust the seating depth using the micrometer feature for precise bullet placement.
- Make incremental adjustments and test the seating depth with a sample cartridge.

5. Using the Neck Sizing Die

- Use the Neck Sizing Die for cases that have already been fired in your specific rifle to maintain proper fit.
- Follow the same procedure as with the Full Length sizing die.

6. PostUse Care

- Clean the dies after use to remove any debris and prevent corrosion.
- Store the die set in its original packaging or a dedicated storage container.
