

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AFrame Revolver Bullets by Swift Bullet. These highquality bullets are designed for use in muzzle loaders and heavy revolvers. This safety instruction guide provides essential information to ensure safe handling and usage of this product in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).
