Die includes an adjustable depth decapping rod. An extra Decapping Punch is included. These dies do not contain an expander. Made of High Quality Heat Treated Steel. These Full Length Bushing dies mimic the neck sizing of Wilsons' neck sizing dies and are designed to leave 3/16" at the bottom of the case neck unsized, a practice many shooters prefer and find to be more accurate than sizing the full neck.
