# Safety Instruction Guide for WILSON STAINLESS NECK DIE PUNCHES

## Introduction

  - 22 BR (Benchrest) Remington
  - 220 Russian
  - 6 mm Dasher
  - 6mm PPC
  - 30 BR (Benchrest)
  - 6 mm BR
  - 220 Beggs
  - 22 Vartarg Turbo
  - 6mm Beggs
- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) such as safety glasses when using the punch.
- Ensure that your work area is clean and free of distractions.
- Do not apply excessive force when using the punch to avoid damaging the tool or causing injury.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation:

- Gather all necessary materials including the WILSON STAINLESS NECK DIE PUNCH, cartridge cases, and a stable workspace.
- Ensure that the area is welllit and free from clutter.

### 2. Using the Punch:

- Select the appropriate caliber punch for your cartridge.

- Align the punch with the primer pocket of the cartridge case.
- Gently but firmly press down on the punch to remove the primer. Avoid excessive force.
- Inspect the case to ensure that the primer has been removed completely.

### 3. PostUse:

- After use, clean the punch to remove any debris or residue.
- Store the punch in a safe place, away from children and pets.
