The handwheel is aluminum with black anodized finish with a stainless steel threaded insert designed for a gall-free lifetime of use. Handwheel utilizes 1-14" threads and is designed for use with the Sinclair Competition Rest series only. The Sinclair Competition Forend Stop is fully adjustable for length (fore and aft), height, and cant. It works with current production Generation II rest tops (Benchrest and All-Purpose). Introduction

- For height adjustment, use the height adjustment feature to raise or lower the Forend Stop as needed.
- To adjust cant, loosen the appropriate adjustment mechanism and set to the desired angle before tightening.

3. Using the Shooting Rest:

- Place your firearm securely on the rest top, ensuring it is stable.
- Adjust the handwheel to secure the firearm in place. Ensure it is firmly tightened.
- When finished, carefully remove the firearm from the rest, ensuring it is pointed in a safe direction.
