Loop models features a stationary loop on the left side of the extension to accept direct attachment of tactical-style slings without swivels. QD stud models include a quick-detach, swivel stud mounted either in the center of the magazine cap or at the front of a plate below the extension to accept slings with quick-detach swivels. All models fit 12 gauge only.

Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON 870/1100/1187 Extended Magazine Tube

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the REMINGTON 870/1100/1187 Extended Magazine Tube from SCATTERGUN TECHNOLOGY.
