Safety Instruction Guide for KIT SPARE PARTS FOR SEMI AUTO BERETTA USA

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Beretta spare parts kit for your semiautomatic firearm. - **Ejector Spring Guide (C52928):**
 - Remove the old ejector spring guide and replace it with the new one.
- **Ejector Spring (C90177):**
 - Install the new ejector spring by following the manufacturer's specifications.
- **Ejector Pin (C97004):**
 - Carefully insert the ejector pin and ensure it is properly seated.
- **Ejector (C54499):**
 - Replace the old ejector with the new one, ensuring it fits snugly.
- **Extractor Pin (C92155):**
 - Install the extractor pin securely.
- **Extractor Spring (C90138):**
 - Replace the extractor spring as per instructions.
- **Extractor (C52238):**
 - Ensure the extractor is properly aligned and secured.
- **Trigger Guard Retaining Pins (C56533, C58984):**
 - Replace both retaining pins as necessary.

- **Connecting Rod (C50581):**
 - Install the connecting rod according to the specifications.
- **Trigger Pin (C92094):**
 - Ensure the trigger pin is properly installed.
- **Cocking Handle (C58933):**
 - Replace the cocking handle as per instructions.
- **Firing Pin (C54731):**
 - Replace the firing pin and ensure it is secured.
- **Firing Pin Spring (C90148):**
 - Install the new firing pin spring carefully.
- **Firing Pin Retaining Pin (C56426):**
 - Ensure the firing pin retaining pin is properly seated.
- **Hammer (C71020):**
 - Install the hammer as per the manufacturer's instructions.
- **Braces (C50738, C50737):**
 - Replace the left and right braces as necessary.
- **Bushings and Rings (C50751, C97019, C53665, C53564, C58970, C58967, C58968):**
 - Ensure all bushings and rings are properly installed and secured.
- **Plug with Swivel (C79043):**
 - Install the plug with swivel securely.
- **Hammer Spring (C90030):**
 - Replace the hammer spring as per instructions.
- **Hammer Bushing (C80675):**
 - Ensure the hammer bushing is properly seated.

3. Final Checks

- After installation, perform a thorough inspection of the firearm to ensure all parts are installed correctly.
- Test the firearm in a safe environment to ensure proper function.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any old or damaged parts in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not throw firearm parts in regular trash; check for local hazardous waste disposal options.
- Ensure that all disposed parts are rendered unusable to prevent misuse.
