Introduction

Thank you for choosing the RUGER® MK II™/MK III™ 10RD 22LR MAGAZINE WITH EXTENDED PAD manufactured by Majestic Arms. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use of your magazine. Please read this manual carefully before use to understand the safety precautions and proper handling of the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the magazine is compatible with your firearm model (Ruger MK II or MK III).
- Always keep the magazine unloaded when not in use.

- Load the magazine with 22LR cartridges by inserting them into the magazine feed lips from the top.

- Ensure that cartridges are seated properly and not jammed.
- Insert the loaded magazine into the firearm and ensure it is securely locked in place.
- Always check that the firearm is in a safe condition before handling or firing.

- **Unloading:**

- To unload, remove the magazine from the firearm.
- Press the magazine release button and pull the magazine out.
- Remove any remaining cartridges from the magazine by pressing them down and allowing them to slide out.
