Introduction

- Align the magazine with the magazine well.
- Push the magazine firmly into the well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine

- Ensure the firearm is on safe and pointed in a safe direction.
- Press the magazine release button to eject the magazine.
- Pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance

- Regularly clean the magazine to ensure proper function.
- Use a soft cloth to wipe down the exterior.

- Inspect the follower and spring for any debris or damage.
