Safety Instruction Guide for 1911 Grip Screw Bushing

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 1911 Grip Screw Bushing from Wilson Combat. This product is designed to replace damaged or stripped grip screw bushings in 1911style firearms. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.
