- Nylon bushing wrench
- One extrapower firing pin spring

2. **Installation of Recoil Springs:**

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Remove the slide from the firearm according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Replace the recoil spring by removing the old spring and inserting the new one, ensuring it is properly seated.
- Reassemble the firearm following the manufacturer's guidelines.

3. **Using the Bushing Wrench:**

- Use the nylon bushing wrench to safely remove and install the barrel bushing.
- Ensure the wrench is securely fitted to avoid slipping during use.

4. **Using SHOKBUFFS:**

- Install SHOKBUFFS as per the instructions provided with your firearm to reduce wear on the frame and slide.

5. Final Checks:

- After installation, conduct a visual inspection to ensure all components are securely in place.
- Perform a function check to ensure the firearm operates correctly before use.
