The anti-snag rear sight is low profile, finger adjustable for windage and has a dual peep with a .200" and .075" aperture. Made in USA from mil-spec anodized aluminum. Folding sights with a low profile when not in use. Steel upright locking mechanism. Standard AR-15 heights with low-profile windage adjustment and standard front sight elevation adjustment.
