Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the REM 700/722/725 & RUGER 77 BLITZSCHNELL STRIKER SPRINGS 28#. This product is designed to improve striker acceleration and help correct ignition problems in your Ruger® 77® firearm. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.
