This set includes two each of the very thinnest bits, which means you'll never be stuck in the middle of a job without the proper bit. The set also includes a complete selection of Phillips, Allen, and Torx bits to cover scope rings, bases, recoil pads, and the like. The difference in the "basic set" and the "professional set" lies in the 15 ingenious "specialty bits" that are included in the "professional" set. These bits are great for installing scope bases, getting you out of a pinch by providing a small pin punch when you really need it, and keeping once-in-a-while lifesaver tools at your fingertips.
