- V-block bedding system to form a solid and reliable base for the rifle action.
- The magazine well has been refined for easy insertion of the magazine.
- Ambidextrous, easy reach magazine latch – can be operated with trigger finger or left hand.
- Barricade stop in front of the magazine to prevent putting pressure on the magazine.
- Compatible with all non-beavertail AR pattern pistol grips. Beavertail grips will fit with minor trimming.

MDT ESS Chassis System Kit Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

4. Adjusting the Buttstock

- Loosen the adjustment knobs for the buttpad and cheek rest.

- Tighten the knobs securely once adjustments are made.

5. Installing the Pistol Grip

- Attach your chosen AR pattern pistol grip, ensuring it is compatible.
- If using a beavertail grip, trim as necessary for a proper fit.
