The short action magazines are offered for WSM cartridges in 7 round capacity. The WSM magazines are available without the front binder plate. Without a binder plate you get a longer COL (2.960" vs 2.870"), but they may require modification to the feed ramp of the receiver. Check if your action would be able to feed 2.960" long cartridges, or have it modified if you want to use magazines without binder plates.

# Safety Instruction Guide for MDT Metal Magazine SA 300WSM/6.5 PRC 7 Round BLK
