The ACC (Adjustable Core Competition) Chassis was created with an integrated weight management system, allowing shooters to fine tune the weight and balance point of the rifle. The adjustability comes from a series of weights that can be added to either the buttstock, interior forend or exterior forend. It's original weight of 2,7 kg transforms into a maximum of 5,6 kg (chassis only - add on your action, barrel, scope and accessories and most shooters are pushing 12-14 kg in the ACC).

MDT ACC Chassis System Kit Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

- Always check that the retention screw on the ARCA/RRS dovetail is tightened before attaching accessories.
- Avoid using the chassis system in adverse weather conditions that could affect performance or safety.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation of Weights:

- Identify the areas where weights can be added: buttstock, interior forend, or exterior forend.
- Select the appropriate weights based on your desired balance and weight distribution.
- Securely attach the weights using the provided fittings. Ensure they are tightly fastened.

2. Using the MDT Elite Grip:

- Ensure the grip is securely attached to the chassis.
- Adjust the grip position to your preference for optimal control.

3. Loading the Firearm:

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- Load the AICS style magazine according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Insert the magazine into the chassis, ensuring it locks into place.
