The guide sleeve has the internal contour of the cartridge chamber to cover the cartridge case.

The guide sleeve and the body of this reloading-die are perfectly matched to ensure exact axial alignment of the cartridge during the sizing process.

Of course, the BR-Neck-sizer has an optional expander and the exchangeable primer ejector pin.

This die is the perfect choice for those, who want to leave nothing to chance when reloading.
