We put our magazines through vigorous testing.

We have used high quality strength polymer with a high glass content to ensure durability and strength.

Although not unbreakable, we have driven over these magazines with cars and trucks which did not break them

The magazine sits flush in the housing of the HNT 26 chassis

They do not work with the following inlets: Browning X-bolt, Winchester XPC and may require fitting in Winchester Model 70.

Based on customer feedback, the following systems work well with our magazines, but fitting may be required in some cases:

- XLR Chassis
- KRG X-Ray - Some need adjustment
- GRS riflestocks- (Configured for AICS magazines)
- CDI Precision bottom metals- (Configured for AICS magazines)
